## **Investment Objective**

The Fund invests principally in Malaysian equity securities. Malaysia is considered to be an emerging market. The Fund is actively managed. The Investment Manager will, when selecting investments for the Fund and for the purposes of monitoring risk, consider the MSCI Malaysia IMI Custom Capped Index (the "Index") as the Index constituents are representative of the type of companies the Fund invests in. When monitoring risk, the Investment Manager references the Index for the purpose of setting internal guidelines. These guidelines represent overall levels of exposure relative to the Index and do not imply that the Fund will invest in the Index constituents although a substantial portion of the Fund's investments is likely to be part of the Index. Where the Fund invests in securities that are included in the Index, its allocation to those securities is likely to differ from the Index allocation. However, given that the market in which the Fund invests is highly concentrated, the overlap between the Fund's portfolio and the Index is expected to be high. The Fund's performance can be assessed against its Index as the Index constituents are representative of the type of companies the Fund invests in.

Annualised Volatility is a measure of how variable returns for a fund or comparative market index have been around their historical average. Two funds may produce the same return over a period. The fund whose monthly returns have varied less will have a lower annualised volatility and will be considered to have achieved its returns with less risk.

Beta is a measure of a fund's sensitivity to market movement (as represented by a market index). The beta of the market is 1.00 by definition. A beta of 1.10 shows that the fund could be expected to perform 10% better than the index in up markets and 10% worse in down markets, assuming all other factors remain constant. Conversely, a beta of 0.85 indicates that the fund could be expected to perform 15% worse than the market return during up markets and 15% better during down markets.

Sharpe Ratio is a measure of a fund's risk adjusted performance taking into account the return on a risk-free investment. The ratio allows an investor to assess whether the fund is generating adequate returns for the level of risk it is taking. The higher the ratio, the better the risk-adjusted performance has been. If the ratio is negative, the fund has returned less than the risk-free rate.

Active Money is the sum of the fund's overweight positions (including effective cash) when compared to the market index.

A position combines all equity investments (including derivatives) linked to an issuing company. Derivatives are included on an exposure basis so they reflect the equivalent underlying shares needed to generate the same return. Geographic and sector breakdown tables are calculated using the positions methodology.

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
