

In addition, the CPF Board will pay an extra interest rate of 1% per annum on the first \$\$60,000.00 of a CPF member's combined balances, including up to \$\$20,000.00 in the CPF-OA. The first \$\$20,000.00 in the CPF-OA and the first \$\$40,000.00 in the CPF-Special Account ("SA") are not allowed to be invested under the CPFIS. Investors should note that the applicable interest rates for each of the CPF accounts may be varied by the CPF Board from time to time.
